Some fastenings can cause lots of frustration for children, so we ask that children wear velcro fastening shoes, so that they can take them on/off easily.



Parent Partnerships – Tapestry and School Website

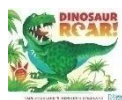

We have our own class page on the school website. Please check our page each week to share in our achievements, see what we have been learning about in school and find out ways that you can support learning at home!

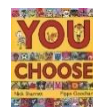
