 - We encourage and support the children to be independent in their self-care, especially with putting their shoes and coat on and off. Some fastenings can cause lots of frustration for children so we ask that children wear velcro fastening shoes so that they can take them on/off easily.
- Your child will soon start to bring a reading book home. You can purchase a book bag from the online uniform shop. Please bring book bags into school every day.

Each half term, we will read 5 key texts. This half term, our 'Favourite 5' books are:






Shark in the Dark Augustus and his Smile Same But Different Too Stanley's Stick Owl Babies
