<b>Victorians</b>	people who were alive when Queen Victoria was the Queen of England, from 1837-1901.
<b>past</b>	something which has already happened
<b>present</b>	what is happening now
<b>future</b>	what will happen or is still to come
<b>modern</b>	things in recent times
<b>old</b>	belonging to the past
<b>compare</b>	to look at what is the same and different about two or more things
<b>decade</b>	Ten years
<b>artefact</b>	a man-made object, such as pieces of art or tools, that is of particular cultural, historical or archaeological interest.
<b>era</b>	A period of time with an important event.
