

How will my child be able to contribute their views?

- Teachers discuss targets and feedback with individual children.
- When reviewing Support Plans, children are encouraged to contribute to their strengths, the ways that they prefer to learn and to their areas for development.
- Children will be invited to share their views and attend annual reviews for their EHCP (Education, Health and Care Plan) or statements wherever possible. This may be done using strategies such as Talking Mats to make it accessible.
- Children are encouraged to talk to staff if they have any concerns, in particular, relating to their emotional health and well-being. This could lead to a referral to our learning mentor Ms Heron.
- Pupils will be selected at random throughout the year to participate in Pupil
 Interviews where they will be asked to give feedback and opinions on a
 variety of whole school matters. Governors may attend these sessions.
- The school council is regularly asked to feedback on any aspect of school life that they may be worried about or that can be improved.
