

Pupils with medical needs

- The school's Medicines in School policy is in line with guidance from the Local Authority and can be found on our website.
- Staff have regular training and updates of conditions and medication so that they are able to manage medical situations that may arise. This may include epilepsy training, diabetes training and has included training on the use of epi-pens when needed.
- Some members of staff have had more specialist training, for example to catheterise a child with spina bifida, when the need has arisen.
- If a pupil has a complex medical condition, then a detailed Care Plan is compiled with the school nurse and in consultation with parents/carers.
- They may also require an Individual Pupil Risk Assessment.
