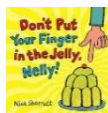
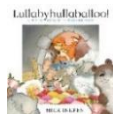
Reminders!

- As usual, our class page is regularly updated, so please check each week to share in our achievements, see what we have been learning about in school and find out ways that you can support learning at home!

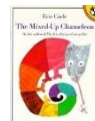
