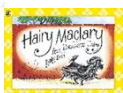
Important Dates

All families should have now received a letter outlining the transition arrangement for their child. Below are some important dates:

Welcome meeting - Wednesday 10th July 2:30pm

This meeting will take place in the school hall. You will find out all about the Reception year, including how children learn in Early Years and how you can support them at home. This is a meeting for parents and carers.

'Stay and Play' – Tuesday 3rd September 9:30-10:30 OR 1:30 – 2:30pm

The 'Stay and Play' session will take place in the Reception classroom. Your child will have the opportunity to meet their new teachers again and play in their new classroom environment. We kindly ask for you to stay with your child for the duration of the session. Please call the office to book either the morning or afternoon session.
