We have another very busy and exciting half term ahead of us in Year 2.

In Maths, we will be working on addition and subtraction and we will be continuing to count in 2s, 5s and 10s. As we start to use these facts to learn the times tables, it would be helpful if you could support your child with this. There are times tables posters available in shops such as 'The Works' or 'W H Smiths' that can help with your child's learning.

In English, we will continue to develop our sentence writing and to improve the words that we use in our writing. We will be using 'Traction Man' as a stimulus, which is an exciting, action story. We will also be using 'Superdad's Day Off' in our reading lessons.

In History, our study unit for this half term is all about the importance of the railways. The children will be learning about George Stephenson and what he invented. We have our visit planned to the National Railway Museum in York.

Science will see us exploring the uses and properties of everyday materials.
