# Year 2 Newsletter




Dear Parent or Carer,

#### **English**

#### Maths

Our Maths learning this term will focus on **Time**. Last half term the children worked extremely hard working with Fractions as they became fractions superstars! This half term we will be moving onto consolidating all our multiplication facts as the children have now learnt their 2s, 5s and 10s. Please encourage your child to practise their times tables at home as well as their number

#### **Spelling**

Your child will have a short 'Spelling quiz' each week and we will communicate their results with you via their spelling sheet. Please encourage your child to practise their spellings little and often throughout the week. I have also set some **Purple Mash** spelling challenges which the children complete in class it would be great to see them having a go at home also!

#### Maths

Please encourage your child to play on **Numbots** regularly at home. Little and often is the perfect approach and will really support your child in learning their key number facts.

Your child's log-in details for Numbots are on the inside cover of their reading records. Each week, a Numbots star is chosen for a special certificate in Celebration Assembly! If you have any difficulties logging on, please come and see me.
